Although Rick is very accomplished, he is your everyday GOOD guy. A great communicator who never meets a stranger, nor considers himself better than anyone. Rick serves his clients personally; he doesn't contract out the work that needs to be done. He is directly involved in their management whether it be burning, cruising, timber harvesting, etc. he is right there in the mix always doing what is in the best interest of his clients.

Rick is very family-oriented; you won't be around him long before you hear him talk about his dear wife Ellen, daughter Rebekah and his son-in-law Dan. He is a faithful Auburn Forestry Alumni and giving of his time and resources to the betterment of the school. He will go out of his way to help those less fortunate and serve others. He is a selfless man. He is an example to the forestry profession and a model we should all try to emulate. In his own words, "I feel strongly, that sharing information about the practice of Forestry to the public is critical and, when the citizens of Alabama realize the forest products industry is one of the largest if not largest in our state, we will well be on our way to ensuring the cooperation of those outside our field. ## **2021-Violations Committee Report**

The Board strongly believes that educating and seeking voluntary compliance will better serve the public interest. Therefore, before pursuing punitive enforcement, corrective and rehabilitative actions will be taken. A summary of investigations is presented below.

#### Complaint No. 21-001

Complaint filed against a Non-Registered Forester by a Forester. Pending Resolution.

#### Complaint No. 21-002

Complaint filed against a Registered Forester by a Non-Registered Forester. Investigation on-going.

#### Complaint No. 21-003

Complaint filed by Landowner against a Non-Registered Forester. Investigation on-going.

Our state Tree Farm program sponsors multiple landowner and youth educational events every year where natural resource professionals come together with private landowners to share knowledge and practical advice.

Tree Farm is much more than a recognition program for forest landowners. It provides landowners with internationally recognized forest certification through the Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification (PEFC). It is also recognized by the Sustainable Forestry Initiative as meeting all of its sustainability standards. As a result, Tree Farm certified landowners are able to show proof of sustainable management and forest products originating from these properties meet
