WRITTEN EXAM INFORMATION

All registrants must take a written examination unless they have at least fifteen (15) years of forestry experience acceptable to the Board. Then they may request an oral examination in writing to be approved by the Board.

Examinations will be administered on dates and at times as deemed necessary by the Board.

Examinations are administered at the <u>Board's headquarters</u> in the Alabama Forestry Commission Building located at 513 Madison Avenue, Montgomery, Alabama. Photo identification will be required on the day of examination.

The exam is open book; however, applicants are restricted to using only those resources (printed material and calculators) they bring with them. (<u>No sharing of resources</u>.) External communication devices (e.g., cell phones, wireless PDAs, etc.) and laptop computers may not be used during the exam.

The examination will be given in two parts. Part I will be given from 8:30 a.m. until lunch and will be turned in prior to leaving for lunch. Part II will be given after lunch until 4 p.m. Each part will consist of approximately three hours.

Examinations will be administered by a Board member or by an individual approved by the Board.

Applicants will be notified, by mail, within thirty days of examination results.
